PRODUCTION FACILITIES & BACKLOTS

Metro Orlando is a complete film and television production community with some of the biggest and brightest names in the industry doing business here. Several notable studios are located in Metro Orlando including:

UNIVERSAL STUDIOS FLORIDA: One of the largest working production facilities outside Hollywood, Universal Studios Florida boasts sound stages and has hosted productions such as the feature film *The Waterboy*, *Pictionary*, *The Academy of County Music Awards* and several high profile music videos including *Creed*, *The Backstreet Boys* and *N'Sync*. Universal's permanent back lot sets include authentic New York streets, Hollywood Boulevards, brownstones, parks and waterfronts, fishing villages and a great selection of interior and exterior locations. The Universal Orlando Resort destination provides even more locales including Universal's Islands of Adventure, Universal CityWalk entertainment complex and three themed hotels. In addition, Universal Studios Florida offers on-site office facilities and vendors, providing lighting and grip, engineering services, audio and sound, camera rental, scenic construction and post production.

CHAPMAN/LEONARD STUDIO & PRODUCTION CENTER: This state-of-the-art facility contains a 9,000-square-foot sound stage with a grid height of 27.5'. The hard cyc covers a 60' x 50' area featuring a Desisti lighting and hoist system. The soundstage comes complete with a full production area including dressing rooms, green room and production offices. Chapman offers on-site office facilities and vendors providing Chapman cranes and dollies, camera rental, duplications, lighting and grip, production and post-production services. Production includes commercials for Nike, 101 Dalmatians, American Express, Compaq Computers and Minute Maid.

SEA WORLD OF FLORIDA/DISCOVERY COVE: Elaborate sea-themed settings, both above and underwater, include an icy Arctic/North Pole with live polar bears, walruses and beluga whales; a Key West setting with a dolphin filled "ocean"; and, a Florida swamp with live manatees. Stunt ski boats and drivers perform on a 17-acre lake while two enclosed theaters and a lakeside stadium are available for game shows, concerts, etc. pending park schedules.
