METRO ORLANDO FILM & ENTERTAINMENT COMMISSION SERVICES

ONE-STOP PERMITTING

Filmmakers need only to contact the Metro Orlando Film & Entertainment Commission (MOFEC), a division of the Metro Orlando Economic Development Commission, to take care of all permitting requirements for governments in Orange, Seminole, Lake and Osceola counties, and the City of Orlando. The MOFEC works as a liaison, streamlining the permitting process and providing "one-stop" service. While a few jurisdictions do implement a permit/filming fee, the MOFEC does not charge for permitting services. Additionally, the MOFEC will coordinate other services, such as police assistance for traffic or crowd control and fire department supervision of pyrotechnic effects.

LOCATION/PRODUCTION ASSISTANCE

The MOFEC houses an extensive digital library of location photographs to help match scripts with appropriate, accessible locations. Just send us a script, and we'll match the locations needed with locations in our area and send you back a complete location package. In addition, individualized scouting tours are arranged for producers who want to evaluate locations in the four-county region.

DATABASE OF SERVICES AND CREW

The MOFEC has a complete database of available support services, technical staff and crews that cater to the individual needs of production executives. In addition, the MOFEC annually publishes the *Orlando Filmbook*, a comprehensive guide to film and television production in Metro Orlando. It contains categorized listings of people and companies that provide goods and services to the industry.

Our website includes full access to the *Orlando Filmbook* online, as well as information on filming in Orlando, locations, one-stop permitting, local resources and industry resources.
